Liverpool City Council and Sefton Council officers have met twice during the preparation of the Bootle Area Action to discuss the potential strategic cross-boundary implications of the emerging plan. The Bootle AAP was also discussed repeatedly during the regular Liverpool City region officer meetings. Liverpool City Council and Sefton Council both agree that the Bootle AAP will not have a strategic impact across the Local Authority boundary in relation to housing, town centres, employment land supply or any other matter.

Moving forward, the Bootle AAP may form an important part of a wider strategic programme of planned regeneration through a joint and collaborative New Town programme and/ or a North Liverpool/ South Sefton Partnership. The AAP will be a key document to inform this work. Both parties will continue dialogue to progress this proposition.
